## GCCHS Participates in Navig8 Leadership Summit

Grade nine students **Hannah McDonald, Brianagh Meaney-Feller, Malinda Saltwater, and Kyra Slavik** earned enrollment into the 4-day water literacy conference called "Navigate" through their participation in Ms. Johanna Dalton's Environmental Sustainability CTF course last semester. Held in Canmore from March 10<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup>, the youth summit invited 80 high school students from all over the province to hear from water experts in a variety of industries as they addressed issues with the quality and quantity of our water in Alberta. These students are required to complete a water/sustainability-based project here in Grande

Cache to reflect what they learned. For the project they are partnering with Student Council for Earth Day on April 22nd when



students will be cleaning up the school grounds. On another day TBA, students will be encouraged to Bring Your Own Banana (and a reusable container) to enjoy a banana split as a reward for their hard work around the school. Representatives from the town public services will also be around to discuss the future of water in Grande Cache.
